


Bangladesh's agriculture sector is the backbone of the national economy, contributing nearly USD 50 billion to GDP and generating employment for millions. The Agro Machinery, Fertilizer & Seeds Expo reflects the country's ongoing agricultural transformation by bringing together innovation, investment, and policy support under one roof. It highlights Bangladesh's vast agribusiness potential, strengthens regional and international partnerships, and promotes sustainable growth across the entire agricultural value chain. The increasing use of modern technologies such as reapers, axial flow pumps, power tillers, combine harvesters, and seed fertilizer drills is transforming traditional farming into a more efficient and commercially viable sector. At the same time, the seeds sector plays a vital role in ensuring food security and improving crop yields for 16.5 million farmers. Rapid agricultural modernization and the widespread adoption of hybrid and high-yield seed varieties have expanded the commercial seed market, which reached USD 312.10 million in 2025 and is projected to grow to USD 421.48 million by 2030, registering a 6.20% CAGR during 2025–2030. Additionally, the fertilizer industry remains critical to agricultural productivity, with annual demand of 6–7 million metric tons, of which 85–90% is met through imports. In FY2022, Bangladesh used 5.69 crore metric tons of fertilizer, including 2.16 crore metric tons of urea, the most widely used fertilizer in the country.





About Agriculture industry

The seed market in Bangladesh is a vital component of the country's agricultural sector, experiencing consistent growth in recent years. In 2024, the market size is estimated at approximately USD 338.98 million, with projections to reach USD 433.88 million by 2029, indicating a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 5.06% during the forecast period.

The agricultural machinery market in Bangladesh has been experiencing significant growth, driven by the increasing need for mechanization to boost agricultural productivity. In 2020, the market size was estimated at approximately USD 1.2 billion, with expectations for continued expansion due to rising demand for modern farming equipment.

Projections indicate that the market will grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.9% from 2024 to 2030, propelled by factors such as population growth, heightened food demand, and a shift towards precision farming practices.

The agrochemicals market in Bangladesh has been experiencing consistent growth, driven by the need to enhance agricultural productivity to support a growing population. Pesticide consumption in the country is projected to reach 17,000 metric tons by 2026, with an average annual increase of 1.3% since 1995. In terms of market value, the agricultural pesticides segment in Bangladesh is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 5.6% from 2024 to 2030.

The fertilizer market in Bangladesh is a vital component of the country's agricultural sector, essential for enhancing crop yields to support a growing population. Annually, Bangladesh consumes approximately 6 million metric tons of chemical fertilizers, with about 80% of this demand met through imports.

In 2022, Bangladesh imported fertilizers worth \$2.39 billion, making it the 13th largest importer globally. The primary sources of these imports were Morocco (\$843 million), China (\$571 million), and Canada (\$503 million).

In summary, the fertilizer market in Bangladesh is substantial, with significant reliance on imports to meet domestic demand. Ongoing efforts to stabilize and enhance this sector are crucial for the country's agricultural productivity and food security.




